TASHKENT, February 3-4 — Uzbekistan State World Languages University higher education. Organized by “Foreign Languages in Uzbekistan” web portal and scientific and methodological e-journal and National Research Center for Innovations in Teaching Foreign Languages, the conference is a fruit of cooperation with U.S. Embassy in Tashkent.

Aiming at creating a platform for opinion and experience exchange, the conference is going to cover following fields of development of English language teaching in Uzbekistan: Materials Design and Curriculum Design; Teachers Training; Assessment; English for Specific Purposes (ESP); Teaching Integrated Skills; Intercultural Communication; ICT in teaching English; Teaching learners with special needs and etc.

Total of 250 participants include representatives of the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Specialized Education, American fellows from Central Asian republics, teachers training centers and retraining institutes, teachers of English working in higher educational institutions in all regions of Uzbekistan, and foreign specialists. English Language Fellows and Fulbright Scholars working in Central Asian republics participate in the conference as speakers.

The conference agenda includes plenary sessions, workshops, Book Ruffle and other formats of professional engagement. Conference organizers selected 80 papers among submissions of ELT professionals to include to a Collection of Conference Materials that is distributed in CDs in the form of software application.

Moreover, to let teachers of English from regions observe the event conference.fledu.uz covers it online and has the materials of the conference on its pages.

Fledu.uz is a web portal and scientific electronic journal under the Uzbekistan State World Languages University.
