
Key words: Multimedia Database, online course, Moodle platform, State National Standard, Levels.

Karimov №1875 "On measures for further improvement of foreign language learning system." December 10, 2012. The question of using modern innovative and information technologies in teaching and learning foreign languages in all stages of continuous education in our Republic is considered very deeply in this document. 

(3) M.A. Yakunchev presents it like the interaction of visual and audio effects managing by interactive software based on modern hardware and software that combine text, sound, graphics, pictures, and videos. (4) We agree with A. Donald’s consideration and also suppose that Multimedia Database is the collection of related multimedia data including text, visual and audio material.

In this article (report) we want to share with our experience of creating Multimedia Database based on Moodle platform for all Levels of teaching and learning foreign languages of the system continuous education in Uzbekistan. It was done in the frames of Republican Project “The Program for the development of information technology and the creation of a multimedia database and teaching methodological materials”. The specialists of UzSWLU and Republican Scientific and Practical Innovative Center were involved in this project. The main aim of it was to create multimedia database for all Levels A1, A2, A2+, B1, B2, B2+ and C1 due to the demands of State National Standard of Uzbekistan.



So, teaching text, visual and audio material was selected. For instance, A1 level includes songs, cartoons, games and video. All this material is selected due to the demands of A1 level of State National Standard.


